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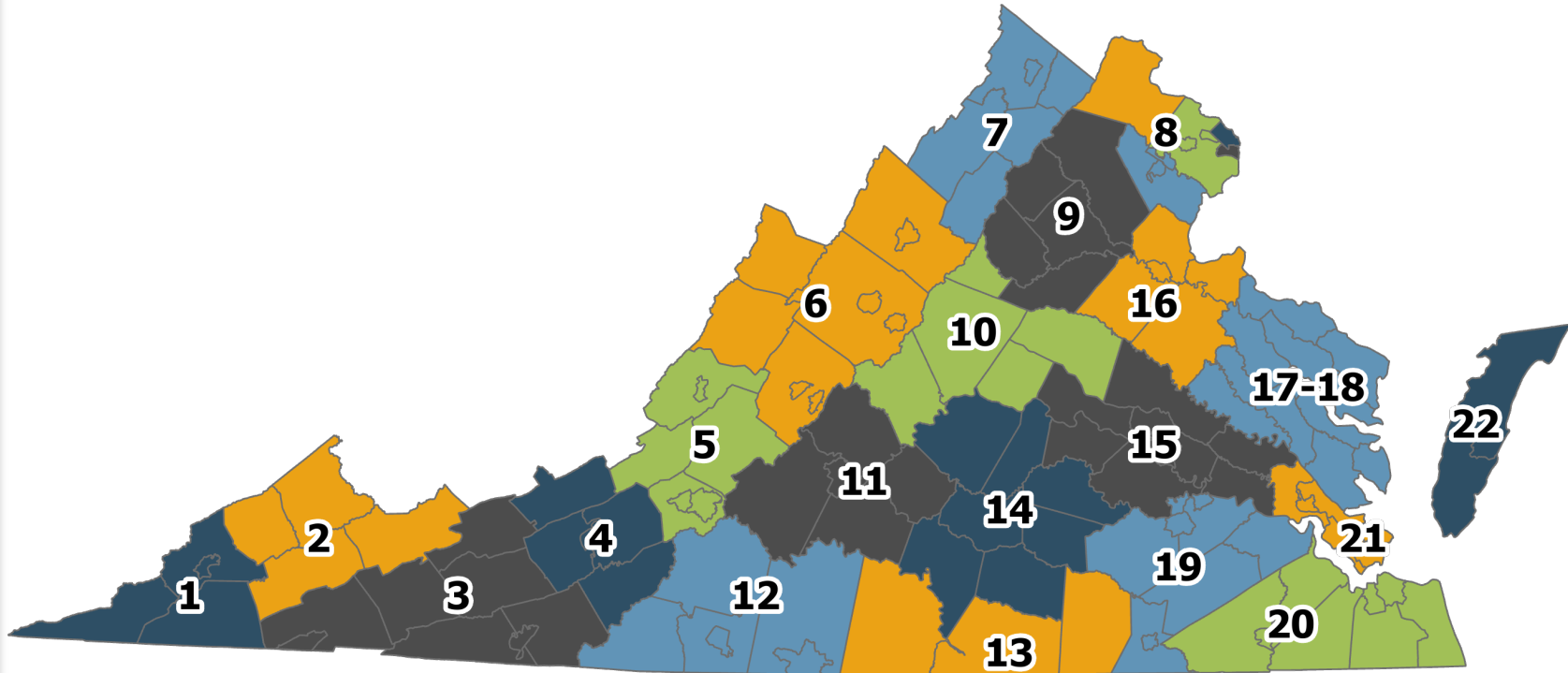


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Planning and Service Area 9 (PSA) includes **Culpeper County, Fauquier County, Madison County, Orange County, and Rappahannock County.**

As of 2020, there were **46,248 Virginians aged 60+**, accounting for **25.2% of the total population** in PSA 9.¹

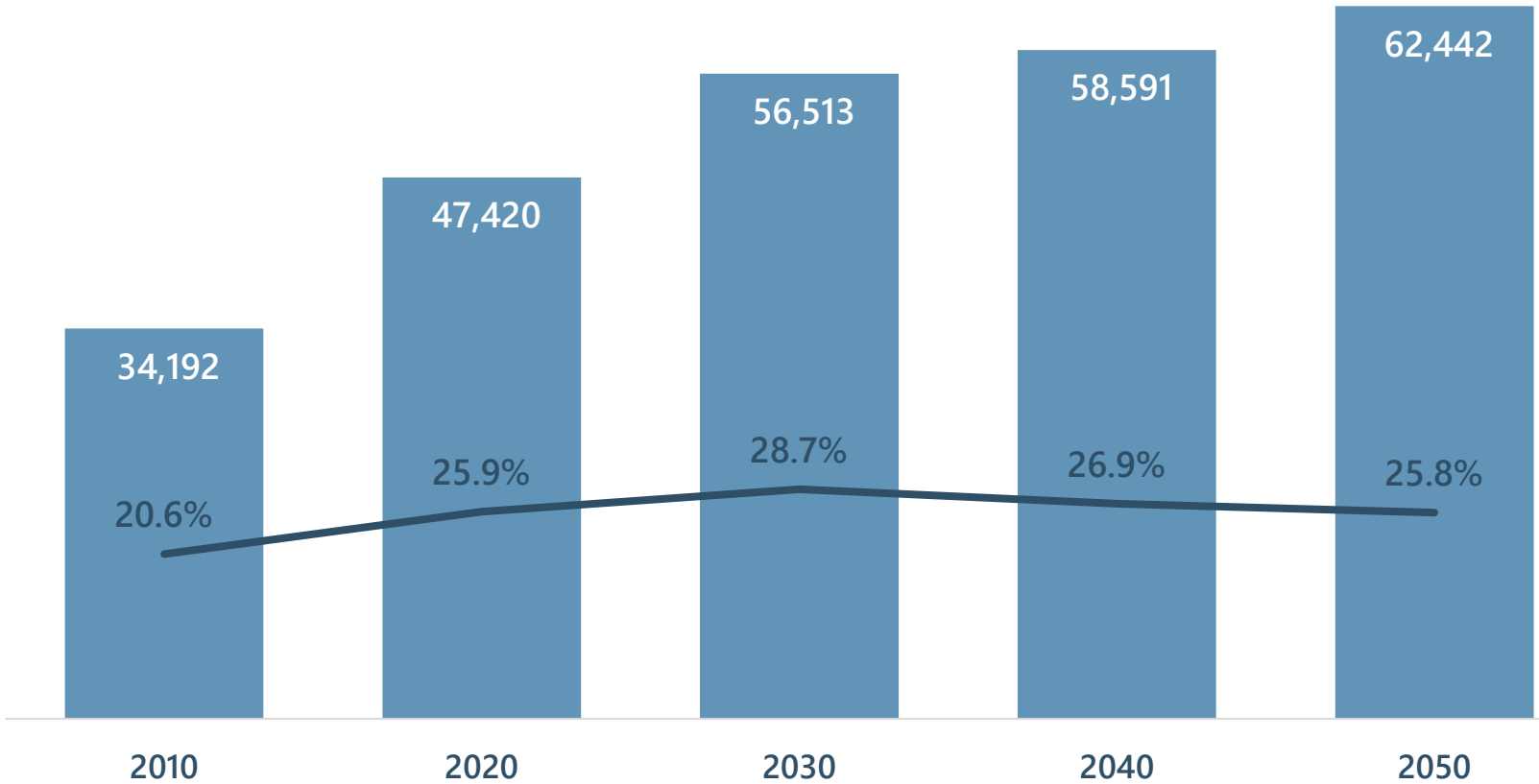


POPULATION PROJECTIONS



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By 2030, Virginians aged 60+ will comprise **28.7%** of the total population in PSA 9.²

The 60+ population in Virginia PSA 9 is **expected to grow** but the **rate of growth is projected to decline** each successive decade until 2050.²

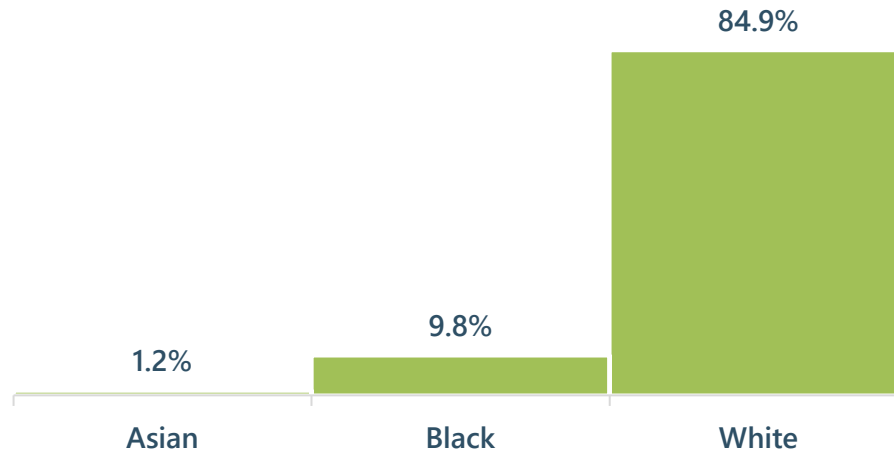


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GENDER, RACE, & HISPANIC ORIGIN

52.8% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 9 were **women** and **47.2% men**.¹

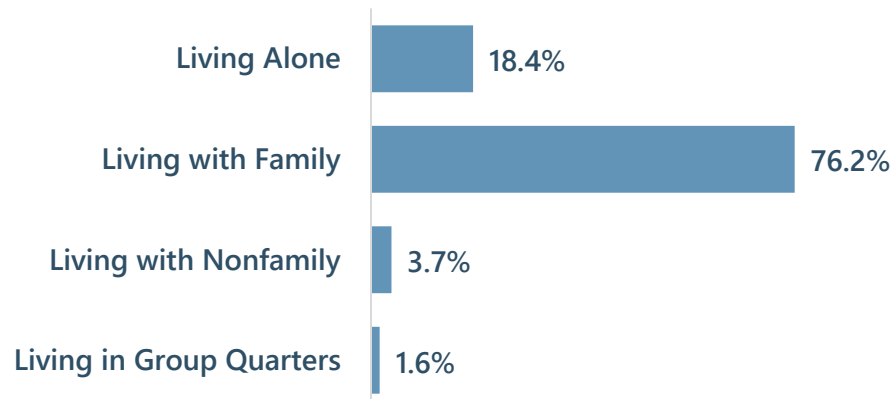
Among 60+ Virginians in PSA 9, **2.7%** were **Hispanic**.¹

Other non-Hispanic racial groups consisted of less than 2%.¹

MARITAL STATUS & LIVING ARRANGEMENT



60+ Adults by Living Arrangement



18.4% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 9 **lived alone**.³

61.5% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 9 were married or partnered, followed by **17.3%** widowed, **11.6%** divorced, **6.1%** never married/single, and **3.5%** separated.³

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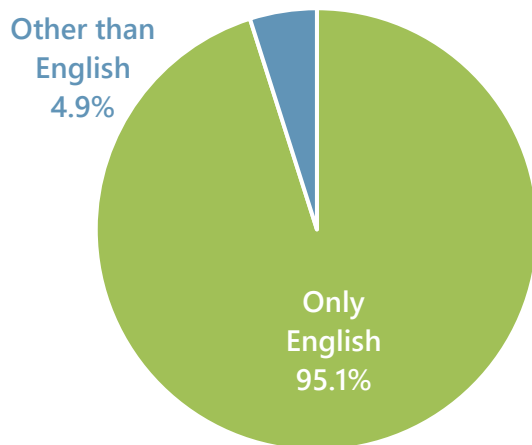


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LANGUAGE SPOKEN AT HOME



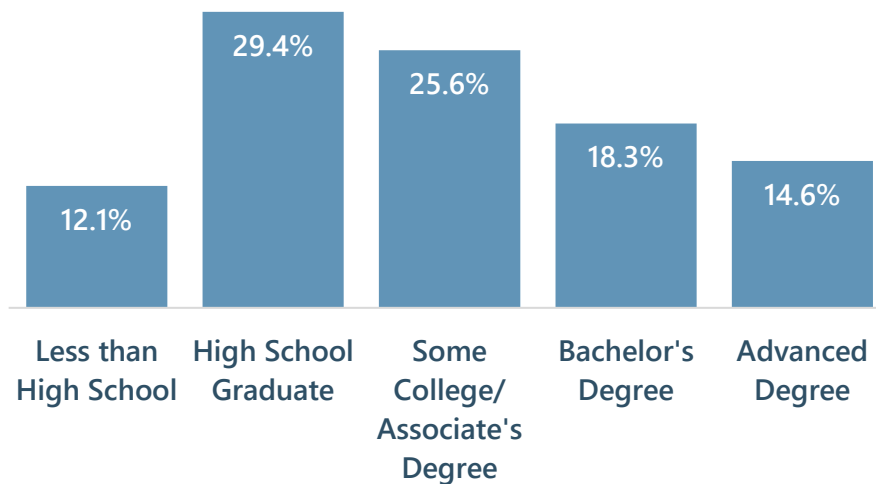
60+ Adults by Language Spoken Most at Home



5.7% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 9 were foreign-born immigrants.³

Among 60+ Virginians in PSA 9, **4.9%** said they mostly **spoke other languages** than English at home.³

EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT



12.1% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 9 had less than a high school education.³

14.6% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 9 had graduate or professional degrees.³

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POVERTY & ECONOMIC STATUS



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5.9% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 9 were **in poverty**.³



5% of households in PSA 9 with 60+ older adults **received food stamps or SNAP**.⁴

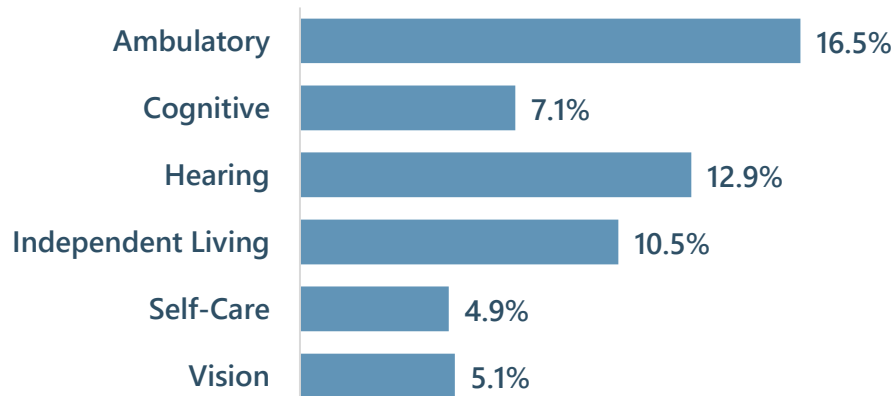


15% of 60+ householders in PSA 9 **rented** their houses.⁴

DISABILITY & HEALTH



60+ Adults by Disability Type



29.5% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 9 had a **disability** and **14.5%** had **two or more types of disabilities**.³

Among those with a disability in PSA 9, **1.5%** had **no health insurance coverage**.³
