



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


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
GENDER, RACE, & HISPANIC ORIGIN

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7.9% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 5 were **in poverty**.³

6.6% of households in PSA 5 with 60+ older adults **received food stamps or SNAP**.⁴



20.3% of 60+ householders in PSA 5 **rented** their houses.⁴


DISABILITY & HEALTH



60+ Adults by Disability Type



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25.7% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 5 had a **disability** and **13.4%** had **two or more types of disabilities** .³

Among those with a disability in PSA 5, **2%** had **no health insurance coverage**.³
