





6.9% of households in PSA 17-18 with 60+ older adults received food stamps or SNAP.⁴




11.9% of 60+ householders in PSA 17-18 **rented** their houses.⁴

DISABILITY & HEALTH



60+ Adults by Disability Type



26.1% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 17-18 had a **disability** and **11.7%** had **two or more types of disabilities** .³

Among those with a disability in PSA 17-18, **0.9%** had **no health insurance coverage**.³
