







6.7% of households in PSA 16 with 60+ older adults **received food stamps or SNAP**.⁴




14.8% of 60+ householders in PSA 16 **rented** their houses.⁴

27% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 16 had a **disability** and **13.4%** had **two or more types of disabilities** .³
